FAI Rules

The following documents will be applicable by consulting the edition effective at the date of the event:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling Volume F3 Radio Control Soaring Model Aircraft 2025 Edition.
- FAI Sporting Code Section 4: Aeromodelling, CIAM General Rules 2025 Edition.
- FAI Sporting Code, General Section 2025 Edition.
- FAI Code of Ethics & FAI Disciplinary Code.

FAI Sporting Licence

Every competitor and each team manager of any national team must possess a valid FAI Sporting Licence (Aeromodelling discipline) registered in the FAI database. A FAI Sporting Licence is not required for the helpers.

The holder of a FAI Sporting Licence may be required to produce, as proof of identity, an official document including his/her names, photograph and signature.

Complaint and protest

The purpose of a complaint is to obtain a correction without the need of making a formal protest. It is recommended that a complaint is made before submitting a protest.

All protests must be presented by the team manager(s) in writing in English to the Contest Director and must be accompanied by the deposit of a fee of EUR 50. In the case of a joint protest, every protesting team manager must pay the protest fee.

Anti-doping statement

A competitor, who needs to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for medical reasons, must have a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) signed by FAI.

UAV regulations

According to the UAS regulations applicable in the European Union (EU), every operator of an UAS needs an operator number from the government. The UAS operator number of the competitor must be visible on every model.

If you are from a country outside of the EU and don't have any operator number, please write an email with name, address, date of birth, telephone and e-mail address to info@modellflugimdaec.de. We will manage registration for you. Cost: EUR 5.

If you are from the EU, please make sure that you have your operator number from your home government on your models.

There is no need for a proof of knowledge or something like that for participating in the competition.

Identification of the models

According to CIAM General Rules Volume C.11.1, each model aircraft shall carry:

- The national identification mark followed by the FAI Unique ID number with letters and numbers at least 25 mm high.
- A model identification code with letters and/or numbers at least 10 mm high, clearly visible and different for each nominated model aircraft of the competitor.

Model Aircraft Specification Certificate and sticker

According to the CIAM General Rules Volume C.12, each NAC shall process every model and shall issue for each model aircraft the Model Aircraft Specification Certificate provided by the FAI. A sticker shall appear on each model aircraft.

Model aircraft not properly processed by their NAC, with FAI certificate and sticker, must be processed by the organizer at a cost of 8 Euro for each model.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

English language always prevails concerning all elements of the competition, namely FAI documents, competition rules and Bulletins.

PARTICIPANTS

Every NAC may enter a team consisting of:

- Team manager
- Assistant Team manager (not mandatory)
- Maximum of 5 individual competitors, providing that at least one competitor is Female and at least one is Junior. According to CIAM General Rules Volume C.5.1, a competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he attains the age of 18. So, a competitor will be considered for the championship(s) as being a junior as long he/she is born from the 1st of January 2007
- All Females and Juniors will compete for the overall individual classification. Additionally, there is a separate Female classification and a separate Junior classification, both with FAI medals and diplomas, depending on the provisions as described in C.15.6.
- Helpers/Supporters

The reigning Champion Bernhard Flixeder (AUT) has the right (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the senior class. If he is not member of his national team, he will not be considered for the national team classification.

The reigning junior Champion Rasmus Krogh Petersen (DEN) have the right (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the junior class. If he is not member of his national team, he will not be considered for the national team classification. When he is no more a junior, he cannot be considered for the individual Junior classification.

Note: The team manager is mandatory but may be a dedicated person or one of the competitors of the national team.

Additional individual competitors (wild card)

According to CIAM General Rules Volume C.5.3 f), the organizer will evaluate after the deadline defined for submission of the Preliminary Entry Form (PEF) the participation level which may be expected. If the number of expected participants is below the minimum number which makes the event financially viable, the organizer will ask CIAM to consider cancelling the championship(s), or to initiate a second phase for accepting additional individual competitors with a 'wild card'.

In case a second phase is initiated, the organizer, with the approval of CIAM Bureau, may send out invitations to the NACs. At the same time, the relevant CIAM Sub Committee (S/C) Chairman may also send invitations considering the World Cup ranking or similar criteria which will ensure that the invited competitors are competent to participate to the championship concerned. Those individual competitors invited by the S/C must also have the approval of their NAC to participate.

All individual competitors invited to participate during that second phase can only be part of the individual classification(s), and so will not be considered for the national team classification.

CLASSIFICATIONS AND AWARDS

Individual Overall Classification

FAI gold, silver and bronze medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third in the individual overall classification for the class concerned. Perpetual CIAM Trophy for the winner. Current holder is Bernhard Flixeder (AUT).

Individual Junior Classification

FAI gold, silver and bronze medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third in the individual junior classification for the class concerned according to CIAM General Rules Volume C.15.6.1.b)

Individual Female Classification

FAI gold, silver and bronze medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third in the individual female classification for the class concerned according to CIAM General Rules Volume C.15.6.1.c)

National Team Classification

FAI gold, silver and bronze medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed national team for the class concerned. Perpetual CIAM Trophy for the winning team. Current holder is Team Germany.

A medal and a diploma will be awarded to the team manager and to all competitors of each national team concerned.

ENTRY FEES

World Championship

- Team manager, Assistant team manager	EUR 410	(includes participation, access to the site, entry to special events,)
- Senior competitor	EUR 410	(includes participation, access to the site, entry to special events)
- Junior competitor	EUR 310	(includes participation, access to the site, entry to special events)
- Female competitor	EUR 310	(includes participation, access to the site, entry to special events)
- Helper/Supporter	EUR 80	(includes participation, access to the site, entry to special events)
- Banquet	EUR 50	

The entry fees defined above include the additional fee of 10 CHF which the organizer must pay to the FAI for a team manager and a competitor.

World Cup "Nardt Open":

- Senior Competitor	EUR 75
- Junior Competitor	EUR 25

Entry Fees must be paid no later than **15**th **May 2025.** Entry fees will not be accepted at the arrival, except for an exceptional circumstance and subject prior to agreement of the organizer. In case a participant or a national team withdraws after the entry fees have been paid, a full or partial refund of the entry fees will be considered only in case of force majeure or exceptional circumstances.

According to CIAM General Rules Volume C.15.5.1 i), a person serving in more than one position (team manager, competitor, official helper, etc.) will be charged only the highest entry fee of the positions to be served.

DEADLINES

Preliminary Entry Form (PEF)

Each NAC which plans to send a national team is requested to fill out the enclosed PEF, and to return it signed and stamped no later than 15th March 2025

According to CIAM General Rules Volume C.15.10, if after the deadline to submit the PEF the number of entries in a class or classes is low, it will be up to the organizer, in consultation with CIAM Bureau, to cancel the competition for the class or classes concerned.

Such decision will be taken after the deadline for the PEF and before the deadline for the Final Entry Form submission. This shall be announced together with the Bulletin 2.

Final Entry Form (FEF)

The final entry form must be sent to the organizer by e-mail no later than 15th May 2025.

Entries received after this date will be subject to a penalty fee. The penalty fee is 20 % of the entry fee.

LODGING AND FOOD

Accommodation

It is up to the teams to arrange accommodation themselves!

Camping

Camping site 200 m to the airfield. Camping fee including electricity and social facilities:

Tent, Caravan, motorhome, etc. EUR 10,00 per day

Lunch / Dinner

Lunch and dinner will be served daily at the airfield by the organizer. Costs EUR 15 each.

"BBQ" - Midweek Party

On Wednesday 13th August there will be a social networking event at the airfield. There will be food and drinks. Costs will be EUR 20.

Banquet

Banquet will take place in the frame of the closing and prize giving ceremony on Friday 15th August in the evening. Costs will be EUR 50.

INSURANCE

The organizer will provide third party insurance for all participants during the competition for accidents involving injury to others and damage to property according to the host country legislation. Participants are responsible for having an aviation liability insurance for model aircraft valid in Germany.

Participants are recommended to organize their own individual health and travel insurance before travelling.
